SHOWJUMPING AND DRESSAGE

I bought Feldstein (a Hanovarian) five years ago as a six-year-old. I initially wanted him as a showjumper and occasionally did a lower dressage test with him. He did well in the showjumping ring but about 18 months ago I decided to take up dressage as my main discipline in riding.

Feldstein is a kind, gentle horse but he is very strong when being ridden. I also found that the travelling and show schedules seem to unsettle him. In the last year, I tried everything possible to keep my horse happy and relaxed. We have travelled to shows monthly for the last 18 months without being placed once in an event. I tried different methods of training and several instructors. I even considered selling him at one stage.

Two months ago, I was introduced to PLOCHER products, and I started using this after reading her reports. I have had the following results:

- My horse is definitely more relaxed and happy.
- He is looking better than ever before – everybody comments on how healthy he looks.
- He seems to be doing well on less food.
- During the last show he was placed 2nd and 3rd in dressage classes and his marks that were normally about 50% increased to 61.5%. He was marked 8 out of 10 for one of his movements. Judges comments ranged from “Wow“ to “Brilliant“.
