



Case Study

DAIRY PRODUCERS

La Chance Farm
Dixville
Canada

This farm normally moves manure to a field to begin composting. In 2002, bulls laid out to pasture in this field all developed pinkeye and required treatment.

Treatment

In March 2003, they tried Plocher Komposter (AK 1551). They piled the manure near the barn and applied the product. They spread 25% of the manure in spring and the remaining 75% in autumn.

Result

The manure became hotter and gave off less odour. It was more decomposed making it easier to move. None of the bulls developed pinkeye and inside the housing, there were far fewer flies.
